The Griffin Museum is excited to offer two summer workshops for students Grades 5 - 9 and one for Elementary Grades 1 - 4.

We know your child will enjoy our offerings that utilize the photograph and other visual arts media for a fun and collaborative educational experience. Each class is structured to build visual literacy skills as well as develop critical thinking skills through artmaking. Although the classes do not require a camera, students are welcome to bring cameras to use in their projects. No photography experience is needed. ***An exhibition of all student art work will go on display at the museum after the completion of all workshops.*** Class size limited to 15.

- July 5 - 9 Collage/ Assemblage Grades 5 - 9
- July 12 - 16 Photo Arts Grades 5 - 9
- July 19 - 23 Creative Arts and Photography Grades 1 - 4

Arts educator Catherine Nasser will lead the workshops. Students may take more than one class. Students grades 5 - 9 who register for two classes, will receive a \$50 discount off of their total price. Classes will run from 9 AM to 3 PM on Monday through Friday with a half hour supervised lunch. Students should bring a packed lunch to class every day. The Elementary class will run 9 AM to Noon.
