Collage/Assemblage Grades 5 - 9
 July 5 - 9 Time: 9 AM - 3 PM
 Cost: \$250 MEMBERS / \$325 NONMEMBERS*

 The Collage Assemblage class is designed to explore multi-media, collage, and assemblage techniques. In each class, students will create 2D and 3D artwork from suggested themes, techniques, or inspiration from artists and art movements. Students will develop individualized artistic styles, creativity, and delve into this popular art form. The class' artwork will be displayed in a culminating art show in the museum galleries.

Photo Arts Grades 5 - 9
 July 12 - 16 Time: 9 AM - 3 PM
 Cost: \$250 MEMBERS / \$325 NONMEMBERS*

 The Photo Arts class is designed to show students that the photograph can be a building block for greater works of art. This class will use digital photography, Adobe Photoshop, and fine art techniques to explore a variety of photographic and artistic styles; such as photo alteration, printmaking, portraiture, and more. Students will use topics from current events, their community, and their own lives as subjects for daily and weekly art works. The class' artwork will be displayed in a culminating art show in the museum galleries.

Elementary Creative Arts and Photography Grades 1 to 4
 July 19 - 23 Time: 9 AM - NOON
 Cost: \$100 MEMBERS / \$175 NONMEMBERS
 \$20 Material fee
 This class is designed to introduce elementary aged children to a variety of photographic and visual art skills. Each day students will have fun exploring a variety of art mediums and introductory photographic activities. Throughout the week, children build art skills as they develop creativity, self-expression, and a love of art.

The Griffin Museum is excited to offer two workshops for students grades 5 - 9 and one for grades 1 - 4. We know your child will enjoy our offerings that utilize the photograph and other visual arts media for a fun and collaborative educational experience. Each class is structured to build visual literacy skills as well as develop critical thinking skills through artmaking. Although the classes do not require a camera, students are welcome to bring cameras to use in their projects. No photography experience is needed. **An exhibition of all student artwork will go on display at the museum after the completion of all workshops.** Class size limited to 15.

Arts educator Catherine Nasser will lead the workshops. Students may take more than one class. Students grades 5-9 who register for the two classes, will receive a \$50 discount off of their total price. The *Collage/Assemblage* and *Photo Arts* classes will run from 9 AM to 3 PM on Monday through Friday with a half hour supervised lunch. Students should bring a packed lunch to class every day. The *Elementary* class will run from 9 AM to NOON.
