

16th Juried Exhibition High School Senior Show: Shooting for Tomorrow

Overview

Each year the Griffin Museum of Photography conducts a Juried Show, which in the last three years has included a separate show for high school seniors. Once again this year, the museum will hold an exhibition for seniors in the area (see list of towns below) as part of its 16th Juried Exhibition Show. In addition to having their work displayed at the museum, one finalist will also be awarded the Joan Johnson Scholarship for \$1,000.

Submission

- Students are required to submit one photograph (no minimum, maximum size – 13" x 19"). Submissions must be accompanied by the attached entry form and checklist as well as an artist statement (250-word limit)
- There is no fee for submission.
- The student must be a high school senior residing in one of the following cities or towns: Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Billerica, Burlington, Cambridge, Carlisle, Chelmsford, Concord, Lexington, Lincoln, Malden, Medford, Melrose, Reading, Somerville, Stoneham, Sudbury, Wakefield, Wilmington, Winchester, and Woburn.
- There is no theme or preferred format for the submission; however, the student's challenge is to select an image that best represents them—personally and photographically. This may be film, digital, black and white, or color. Is the image technically well produced? Is the composition compelling and original?
- Please provide a return envelope and pre-paid postage if you would like your print returned. Submissions will not be returned if the proper amount of postage is not included.

Schedule

- Submissions should be sent to the museum from March 15th, 2010 to April 23rd, 2010.
- The jurying process will take place in early May 2010.
- Finalists will be notified in late May 2010.

- Once finalists are notified, they should send a framed and matted copy of their print for the show to the museum by June 15th, 2010.
- The exhibition will take place from June 30th, 2010 to August 29th, 2010 in the Griffin Gallery. During this time period, the 16th Annual Juried Show will also be exhibited in the Main Gallery of the museum.

Renowned photographer Andrea Rosenthal and photography professor Sejal Patel will serve as jurors of the show. First, they will select the recipient of the *Joan Johnson Scholarship*. This recipient, along with other finalists, will have their work displayed in the Griffin Gallery of the museum. The jurors will write a statement of the work to accompany the show and at the same time the 16th Juried Show Exhibition will take place in the Main Gallery of the museum.

Goals

- To expand the museum's exposure in the surrounding community.
- To provide an incentive for students to engage in photography and self expression
- To improve student proficiency in image-making and visual art awareness.
- To expose the student to the process of preparing for a professional juried submission.
- To improve student analytical skills in the selection of their best work.
- To encourage students to develop their own personal style in photography



Checklist
